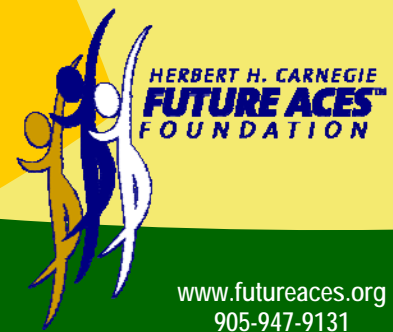

Six Hundred students and guests helped Herb Carnegie welcome his journey into his 90th year. November 6th, 2009 the **Herbert H. Carnegie Public School** hosted a wing ding of a celebration. Herb was emotional as students performed raps, songs and played a special video sharing their feelings about his contribution to their lives.

Leslie Ashworth, a twelve-year old violin prodigy, performed her own composition entitled "A Child's Dream". She then presented a framed copy of her music script to Herb.

Chuck Ealey, Regional Director with Investors Group Financial Services spoke of its great community partnership with Future Aces. The Toronto Area Regions gave the Foundation a \$10,000 cheque to further their work with youth and a commemorative gift to each student. 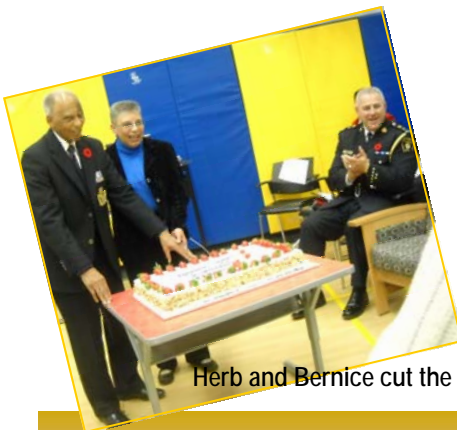
